2014 will be the 15th year that the Great Lakes Yacht Club's Early Bird Regatta has been a Leukemia Cup event. Fund raising through sailing has helped thousands who have been afflicted with blood cancer diseases. Generous participating supporters in the Early Bird Regatta alone have raised over half of a million dollars for blood cancer cure and treatment research since 1999.

Last year Crescent Sail Yacht Club initiated the F Course for various small boat one design classes and this year Detroit Yacht Club will host the Detroit River Course on Friday evening, May 16, 2014, the day before the Saturday Early Bird Regatta. The Detroit River Course classes will be Flying Scots, U20's, Cal 25 JAM, and Kayaks

2014 Leukemia Cup Registration Information for the Detroit River Course at DYC

Friday Evening May 16, 2014 with a start and finish off DYC's Main Dock.

The Warning Signal will be at 1900 hours.

Sailboats will be on a course up river to one of three marks at either Lakewood Park, BYC, or EBC, depending on wind direction and velocity with a goal of having a race that is about one hour long. Specific sailing instructions will be published in early April.

Kayaks will be given a course in early April as well. The kayak participation is not intended to be a race.

We have a two-fold purpose ó Have some fun and participate in Fund Raising for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society. We chose Friday evening because many people who will be participating in the GLYC Early Bird Regatta as skipper or crew can join us on Friday evening as well. The Saturday Early Bird Regatta is also a Leukemia Cup event. The Saturday Courses are the traditional A & C courses as well as a small boat F course near CSYC.

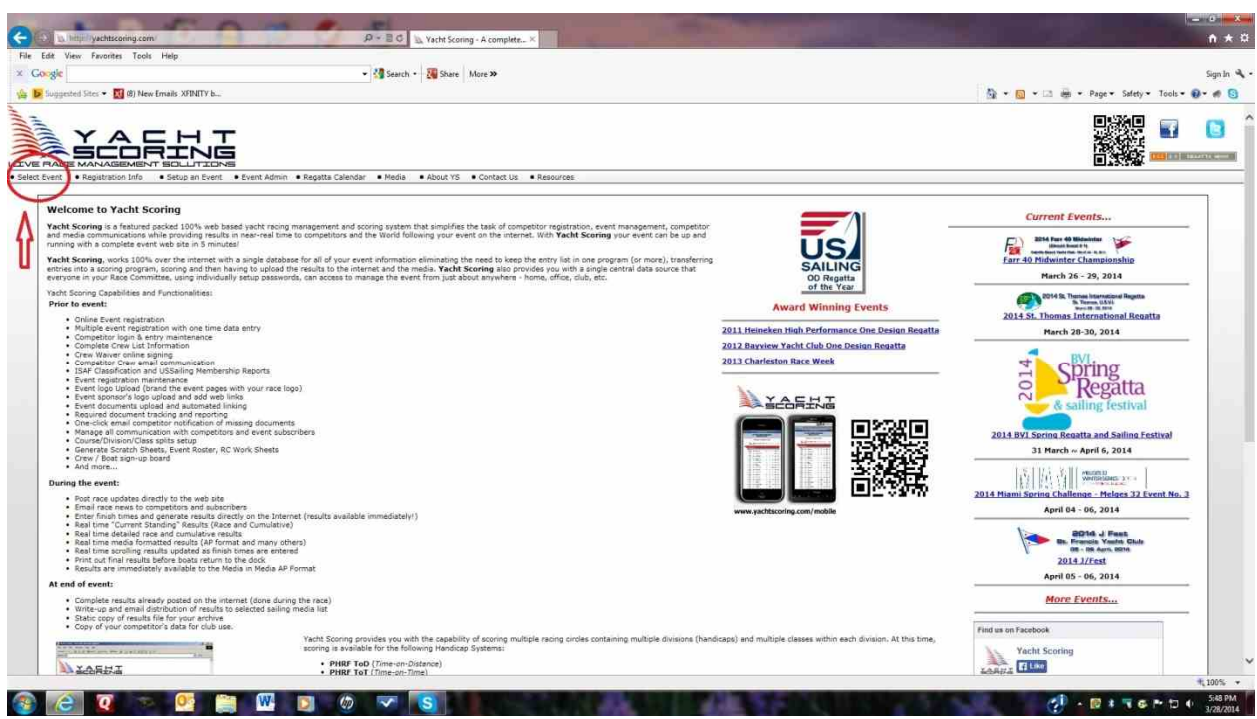
Any Skipper who registers and pledges a donation for one of the Saturday courses may participate in one of the Friday Detroit River classes without an additional donation, although additional donations will be gratefully accepted.

Participation in the Friday Evening Detroit River Course requires a tax deductible donation to the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. The minimum donation for the Friday Course is \$50 paid in advance either on line or with a paper registration.

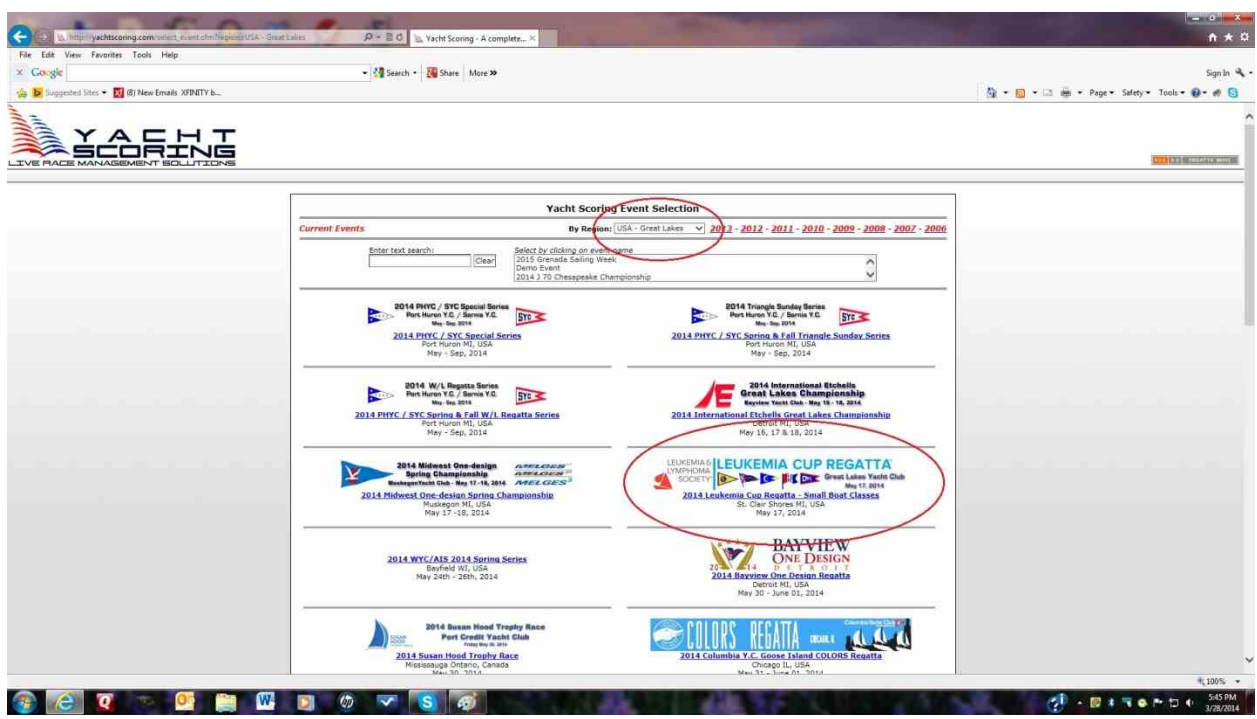
Skippers for Friday can register either individually or create a team so that crew members or followers and friends may participate with donations as well.

Registration is a two-step process. Skippers must register with Yacht Scoring to be listed and they must register with Leukemia Cup online or with a mail in donation registration.

Log on to www.yachtscoring.com and click on Select Event in the upper left corner of the page



Then select Great Lakes from the drop down box at the top middle and then choose the Leukemia Cup.



Enter your email and password if you have registered before, or just your email and select "continue and look up my information".

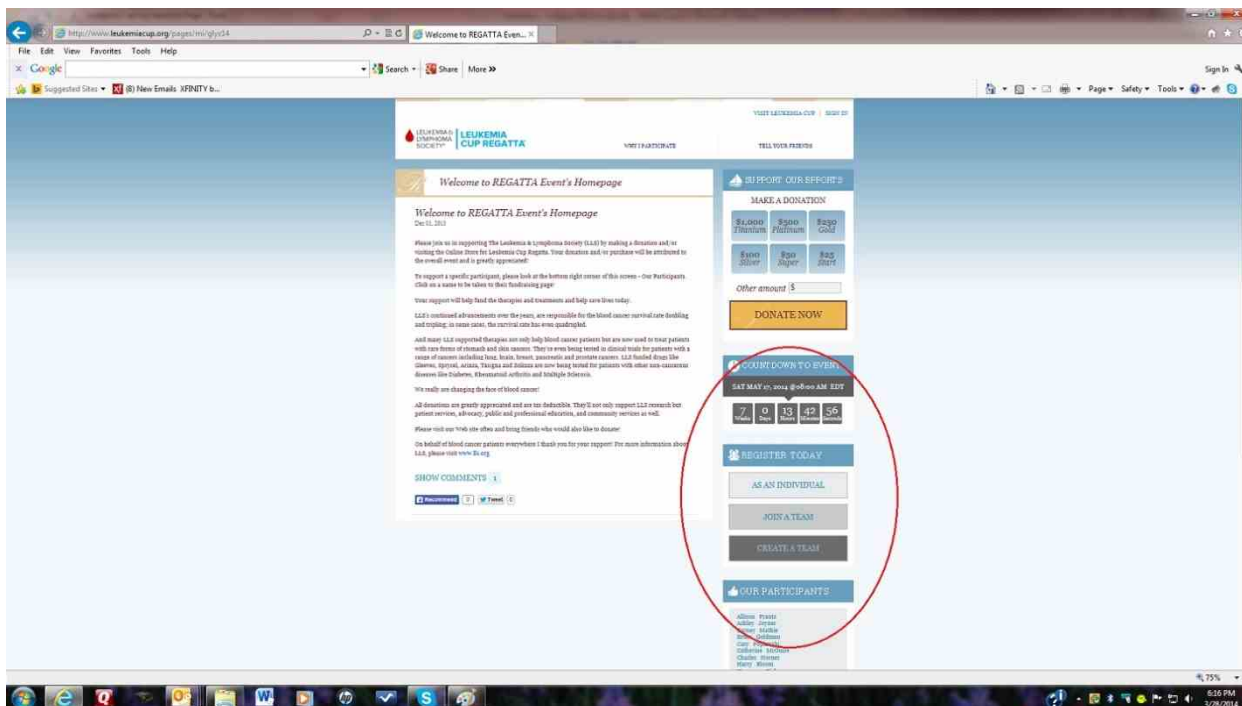
